

Green County 2010 Statistics...

Population:

- 36,909 (9.5% increase since 2000)
- Largest increases in population in townships of: Exeter (60%), York (49%), and New Glarus (42%)

Labor Force Participation Rate:

- 69% (percent of all working age people, non-disabled, who are looking for work or working)

Income:

- Per capita income: \$26,852 (Wisconsin \$27,192)
- Median household income: \$53,933 (Wisconsin \$52,374)
- Percent of total population living in Poverty: 9.7%
- Percent of children living in poverty: 14.5% (increase from 9.9% in 2007)

Age:

- 2010 median age: 41.1 (Wisconsin median age 38.5)
- Over 65 years of age: 14.9% (Wisconsin 13.7%)
- 32% percent of population will be over 65 by the year 2020.
- 25% of population will be 20 and under by the year 2020.

Diversity:

- 97.8% white/Caucasion; 0.5% black/African American; 0.6% Asian; 0.9% two or more races, 2.9% Hispanic or Latino origin
