What to Bring with You:

- Photo I.D.
- Social Security Card
- Copy of last year's tax return
- W-2's
- Any 1099 forms
- Unemployment compensation statements
- Checkbook or other pre-printed direct deposit information
- All other relevant materials for the current year
- 2014 property tax bills and/or rent certificates (if filing Homestead Credit Claim)
- Proof of any Federal or State income tax already paid
- Receipts for any itemized deductions or credits.
- **Proof of compliance with the Affordable Care Act**
 - Proof of healthcare coverage
 - Form 1095-A if you purchased insurance through the Marketplace/Exchange
 - Documentation of Health Care Exemption
