

**FOODS AND NUTRITION COMMITTEE

**New Business:**

The letter that the office needs to send out to all foods and nutrition members was updated. It will follow the same as last year's letter with the exception of the info about a kickoff get together as that is not happening this year. All other info will be updated with this year's dates for events and changes made for exhibiting. One letter will contain info on the workshops, cake revue and foods revue. The planned date for the letter to go out is Jan. 16.

1-2-3-4 Decorate workshop will take place on Saturday Feb 24 from 2-4pm at the Justice Center. Registration deadline will be Feb. 16. Members will be divided up according to their skill levels (not necessarily by age) and certain techniques will be taught each with their own leader.

Master Chef workshop will be held on Feb. 3 from 9am to noon at Zwingly Methodist Church in Monticello. Members again will be divided up and prepare different foods that will come together in a dinner eaten by all attendees as a family.

Registration deadline for this is January 26.

Discussion took place for any changes in the exhibits for this project for 2018.

**Cake Revue:**

Level A 1 and 2 will stay the same. #3 will be a single layer cake up to 9” decorated without tips

Level B 4 and 5 will stay the same. #6 will be a character cake using a mold

Level C 7 and 9 will stay the same. #8 will include spring, Easter, or St. Patrick's.

Level D 11 will stay the same. #10 will be a 3 tiered cake, own design  
#12 design using a minimum of 24 cupcakes.

**Foods Revue**

Level A #1 Deviled eggs will be replaced by breakfast Muffins, plate of 3

Level B Everything remains the same

Level C Any food using watermelon is replaced by stir-fry meal.

Level D 10 and 12 will stay the same. # 11 will be international meal with main course one side.

No educational exhibits will be part of the Foods Revue this year, these will be moved to be fair exhibits.

**Fair Exhibits:**

Grade 3-4 Remain the same

Grade 5-6 #4 pretzel will be replaced by Bundt Cake, no frosting

Grade 7-9 remain the same

Grade 10 and up #11 take off pastry
