



## Green County Pesticide Application Training Sessions

Green County UW-Extension will be hosting two Pesticide Application Training sessions and one Test Only Session at the Green County Justice Center, 2841 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Monroe WI. Smart Phones are not allowed during the Pesticide Exam periods. Participants are allowed to bring and use a calculator if they choose.

### **One Day Session** (Must score 50%+ on exam)

**Monday, February 24, 2020      \*10 AM – 3:30 PM**

*\*A 30 minute break for lunch will be given at the one day sessions. Participants are encouraged to bring their own bagged lunch. Participants can also leave for lunch as long as they can get back within the 30 minute lunch break. Some snacks will be provided.*

### **Test Only Session** (Must score 70%+ on exam through self study)

**By appointment only.**

*The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection requires photo identification at all testing sessions and your social security number is required by state statute because you are applying for a state applicator license. The DATCP will not score tests that do not include a Social Security Number. All participant data is kept confidential and documents are shredded after they are sent to the state.*
