The Benefits of Asking Powerful Questions

- The art of effectively asking powerful questions is an essential leadership habit.
- The quality of your question determines the quality of your answer -- not all questions are created equal.

Impact & Outcomes

- Who is impacted?
- How will this decision impact the future?
- What is the expected outcome?
- What are possible outcomes?

Resources

- What resources are needed to make this happen?
- Where will resources come from?
- How will resources be allocated?

Timeline

- What is the timeline for this decision/project/program?

Benefits

- What are the benefits of this decision?

Challenges & Risks

- What are the challenges and risks associated with this decision?

Context

- Has this been done in the past?
- Are there past experiences with this?
- What is the background and context related to this decision?

Options

- What other options or solutions might be out there?
