- 1) How many post crown tops are built into the wooden bridge at the main entrance?
- 2) How many coniferous trees are growing on the roadside just past the bridge?
- 3) What constant natural noisemaker can be heard from the bridge?
- 4) How long is the trail that starts at the bridge? (Hint...check the map; you don't have to hike it.)
- 5) Who is the nature conservancy dedicated to?

Follow the path to the Children's Fishing Park.

- 6) How many squares are there in the decorative trellis by the Butterfly Garden?
- 7) What is “The Thinking Spot?”
- 8) According to “The Cycle of Life: The Bullfrog” educational display, what is a frog with a tail and four legs/feet called?
- 9) Which pond is shown in the picture at the right? Who lives there?
- 10) Find the “Waterfowl Migration” educational display. What hangs in the tree in front of it?
