

# Green County Master Gardeners Association (GCMGA)

## Scholarship Application

The Green County Master Gardeners Association (GCMGA) will award up to \$1,000 in annual scholarships to graduates of Green County area High Schools, or Green County residents enrolled in secondary education.

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage individuals to take advantage of continuing educational opportunities in a field related to horticulture. Applicants may attend a four-year public, private college or a Technical College either within the state of Wisconsin or outside of the state.

The recipient of this scholarship will receive the funds after they have successfully completed one semester of study. A copy of their first semester grades and proof of re-enrollment (new class listing) for the next semester must be sent to the committee before the scholarship will be awarded. This information must be submitted to the GCMGA Scholarship Committee within 90 days of the completion of the first semester. If not, the scholarship will be voided.
