

GREEN COUNTY PORK PRODUCERS SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to any Green County resident who is attending, or planning to attend a College, Technical School, Vocational School, Short Course or any other institute of higher learning. The amount awarded to each recipient will be determined by the number of applicants selected. The applicant or parents need not be members of the Pork Producers to apply, but first consideration will be given to those that have assisted at the group's sponsored promotional events. The applicants do not have to be entering an agriculture related field.

Previous applicants that have not been granted a scholarship may re-apply, but first preference is given to new applicants. Recipients will be selected at the discretion of the Green County Pork Producers board of directors. Previous recipients of this scholarship are not eligible to apply for a second scholarship.
