High Point Contest



The High Point Contest is intended to encourage participation of all 4-H Horse Project and 4-H Horseless Horse Project members and reward a commitment to learning and involvement inside and outside the arena.

RULES:

Participants must be an enrolled 4-H Green County member by November 1, 2021 and have paid their 4-H Horse Project Dues by April 15, 2022.

There are three divisions that members can participate in, which include:

Jr. Jr. - Grades 3-5

Jr. - Grades 6-8

Sr. - Grades 9-13

Each division will award a Champion High-Point winner based on the number of points accumulated during the current project season, beginning at the Kick-off Open House and ending September 30th of each 4-H year. Points will be earned by hours of participation in the following 4-H sanctioned opportunities:

- Attending Green County 4-H Horse & Pony Project sponsored clinics, workshops and shows
- Attending WI State 4-H Horse Association sponsored events and contests
- Attending the Green County Fair sponsored Junior Horse Show
- Volunteering at 4-H and County Fair sponsored shows and project sponsored events
- Attending monthly Green County 4-H Horse & Pony Project committee meetings

It is required that a clinic or event representative signs the member's High Point Form the day of the event. Only 4-H sanctioned events are eligible.

By October 1, 2022, mail or deliver High Point form to: Extension Green County, 2841 6th St, Monroe, WI 53566 or email to: ellen.andrews@wisc.edu. Forms turned in after October 1, 2022 are ineligible for awards.

Winners will be announced and awarded at the Horse & Pony Project Kick-Off event of the following year.
