4-H is a **community** of **young people** across **America** who are learning **leadership**, **citizenship** and **life skills**.

What is 4-H?

- We are the largest youth organization in the world.
- We are passionate about positive youth development and building strong leaders and citizens.
- We come together and welcome everyone from all walks of life with varying backgrounds and experiences to share with our youth.
- We involve people of all ages, from 5-105 years old.
- We live everywhere - in the city, in the country, and on farms.



Why should I join 4-H?

- To meet new people and make new friends
- To discover and explore new topics and ideas that may lead to your future career choice
- To develop valuable life skills such as communication, confidence, leadership, compassion, and resiliency
- To make your community a better place to live by helping with service projects
- To be empowered with decision-making responsibilities in youth leadership positions



Who can join 4-H?

Youth in grades 5K through one year past high school can join 4-H.

How do I join 4-H?

Start by contacting the organizational leader(s) of a few different clubs you'd like to visit*. Decide which club will best fit the needs of your family (meeting location and time, size of club, etc.), then contact your organizational leader(s) or the Green County UW-Extension office for information on how to enroll online. Once you're enrolled, start getting involved, learning, and having fun!

When can I join 4-H?

You can join 4-H at any time of the year, although our main enrollment period is Sep 1 - Nov 1. If you want to exhibit at the Green County Fair, new 4-H families need to be enrolled by Jan. 15.
