Wildlife WHEP & Forestry 4-H Friends,

Wisconsin has a vast and diverse geography formed over millions of years. Some of the notable features are:

Volcanic cliffs: water from melting glaciers exposed rock from ancient volcanoes.

Bluffs, mesas, or pinnacles: the waters of glacial lakes eroded sandstone into strange landforms

Erratics: rocks moved great distances by glaciers

Escarpments: hard rocks that resist erosion formed steep cliffs

Drumlins: glaciers created long smooth round hills shaped like teardrops

Moraines: where glaciers stopped or rested, they left behind ridges of rocks and sediments Kettles: when glacial ice trapped under the ground melted, it formed kettle holes and lakes

Kames: glaciers formed cone-shaped hills

How many of these can you find on your outdoor walks and park visits, on a scenic drive or even on signage along the highways? Maybe you will want to keep a log of all the different land formations you observe.

Did you know that Wisconsin was once covered by a large sea? Because of this the state fossil is the trilobite - an ancient sea bug that lived in the seas and coral reefs that covered Wisconsin 250 to 500 million years ago. Have you ever found any fossils?
