



Colony Brands Mini Grant Application Form

Thanks to a very generous donation from Colony Brands and their employees as part of their 2022 Associate Donation Program, the Green County 4-H Adult Leaders Association is happy to offer two mini-grant opportunities.

- **4-H Club Mini Grants** - Each 4-H club can request a one-time funding equaling \$4 per enrolled member. The club must provide a description of how they will use the funds to **engage and connect members** (i.e. recreation, community service, hands-on activities, refreshments). Adult leaders are encouraged to work with youth in planning these program opportunities. Once grant requests are approved, funds will be transferred to the club to use at their discretion.
- **4-H Project Mini Grants** - County and club 4-H project leaders can request funding (\$50-\$200) to cover expenses for a 4-H project learning experience. The project leader must provide a description of how the funds will be used to help youth **explore or learn more about a project** area (purchase supplies, hire a guest speaker, rent a space, etc.). Adult leaders are encouraged to work with youth leaders and project members to plan these program opportunities. Approved funding requests from county level 4-H Project Committees will have funds transferred to the specific project line item. Approved funding requests from individual 4-H Project Leaders will be paid out upon submission of receipts.
