 recommendation.

UPDATE AS OF JUNE 2023

After considering this recommendation, the Green County Board budgeted funds to conduct a 5-year groundwater quality trend data program. This work is currently in Year 4 of the data analysis; data has been shared with the well owners and the trend data work will be presented at the Green County Board meeting in June 2023.
