

April 9th PAC Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Megan Leitner at 7:00pm in the Green County Justice Center.

Mirielle Smith gave the secretary's report. No changes were made.

Megan Leitner gave the treasurer's report, the balance stayed the same at \$207.81.

Art in the Park is on April 20th, currently there are ten kids signed up. Snacks will be available. We will ask the office about printed name tags and the 4-H banners for the shelter in the New Glarus Woods State Park.

The Theatre Troupe will work on practicing games and will get a slot in the Talent Show designated for them to perform.

The Concert Band had a trip to see the UW Madison Band.

On May 25th the Concert Band will be performing at the Monroe Arts Center. Dress nicely, the colors preferred are black, grey, and white. There will be a baked good celebration afterwards.

There was a suggestion to take the year off of the Concert Band T-shirts, to make them more universal. Another suggestion was to add 'Est. 2024' printed on the T-shirts as well.

The Talent Show will eventually get promoted more coming up, we are waiting to get the permit approved by the Monroe City Council. The Band Shell has been rented out for both the night of the performance and the rehearsal. Coming up there may be a purchase of slightly used speakers from Tower Sound out of Freeport, IL. There will be trophies for the Talent Show performers, and medals for the Concert Band. If a youth participates in the Theatre Troupe and Talent Show they will only receive one trophy.

There is a thirty act maximum for the Talent Show, and the sign up sheet will be changed to 3rd grade and up can do two acts. Each act can be a maximum of three minutes and thirty seconds, in order to save time. Registration for the Talent Show will end on May 19th.

Area Animal Science Day will be June 20th. We will be selling meals to the youth participants. We will be selling popsicles (3 for \$1), Gatorade (\$2), and Water (\$1) on the side as extra profit. Majority vote is that we sell these items on the side.

Next meeting is on May 7th.

Megan Leitner moved to adjourn the meeting; it was seconded by Noah Kruse. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 7:45pm.
