This project is a pilot program that plants native prairies within on-ramps, off-ramps, and other highway land that is currently being mowed. Benefits of the Highway Beautification project include improved biodiversity, soil health, pollinator habitat, a reduced number of non-native invasive grasses, and aesthetic value.

In addition to the ecological benefits, the Highway Department will save time and money due to less mowing and maintenance costs. As the prairie continues to establish itself and expand, the benefits will multiply. This project is a pilot in the hopes that it can be expanded to other ramps and counties across the state and beyond to increase the aesthetic and ecological value of land along our state's highways.
