

# Green County Master Gardeners Association (GCMGA)

## Scholarship Application

The Green County Master Gardeners Association (GCMGA) will award up to \$1,000 in annual scholarships to graduates of Green County area high schools or Green County residents enrolled in **continuing educational opportunities in agronomy, botany, horticulture or a related field**. Applicants may attend a four-year public, private college or a Technical College either within the state of Wisconsin or outside of the state. This includes students already attending college or a Technical College.

The recipient of this scholarship will receive the funds after they have successfully completed one semester of study. A copy of their first semester grades and proof of re-enrollment (new class listing) for the next semester must be sent to the committee before the scholarship will be awarded. Students currently enrolled in college or technical college should submit their current semester grades and proof of re-enrollment. **This information must be submitted to the GCMGA Scholarship Committee within 90 days of the completion of the semester.** If not, the scholarship will be voided.
