 - c. Green County 4-H 2025-2026 Program Policy Overview, which includes...
 - i. Clubs charged \$15 per youth in returning 4-H families. "Returning families" are those family enrolled as of April 2025. Extension will send club invoices after November 1st.
 - ii. November 1st re-enrollment deadline; January 15th new member enrollment deadline for Member-in-Good Standing
 - iii. No project enrollment deadline
 - iv. Cloverbuds must be enrolled by April 1st to exhibit at the County Fair
 - v. Continuation of attendance requirement (four (4) 4-H meetings, events or workshops; min of 2 club meetings)

16. NEW & Continuing 4-H Volunteer Enrollment Deadline & Traning Requirements

- a. NEW things...
 - i. All 4-H Adult Volunteers will need to complete just 1 online training annually. This Volunteer Training will be found right in your 4HOnline profile, take approx. 40 min., and will automatically mark complete.
 - ii. All returning 4-H Adult Volunteers, as per new WI 4-H policy, must...
 - 1. Re-enroll by November 1st
 - 2. Complete the required training and background check (if needed) by December 1st
- b. Continuing things...
 - i. Background check required every 2 years. If you are due, 4HOnline will prompt you to start the process when you re-enroll and then you'll get an email from *HireRight* to complete the background check.
 - ii. New 4-H Adult Volunteer will still need to meet with Ellen before enrollment can be approved.
- 17. **NEW** 4-H Club & Group Bylaws Due to Extension Office by November 1, 2025. Encouraged to use the 4-H template. Must be inline with County 4-H policies.
- **18.** <u>4-H Charter Application</u> Submit online between September 1 November 1, 2025. Pre-planning will include smart goals and possible activity list for the upcoming year, plus confirmation of meeting time and handi-cap accessible meeting location.
 - a. Involve youth in setting Expanding Access and Program Quality SMART Goals.
 - b. Involve youth and families in deciding whether Club Fundraising Activities are wanted and needed.
 - c. Indicate any activities or projects that your club might do this year.

19. Encourage Participation in State 4-H Opportunities

- a. 4-H Educational Travel Experiences and Scholarships (i.e. Ignite: Animal Science, STEM or CWF March 2026)
- b. 4-H Art Camp October 4-5, 2025 at Upham Woods for 6th-8th grades. Register in 4HOnline by Aug. 28th.
- c. <u>4-H Fall Forum</u> October 31-Novmeber 2, 2025 at Green Lake Conference Center for 4-H Adult Volunteers & youth in 7th grade & older. Registration opens in 4HOnline September 8^{th.} Carpooling may be an option! Registration, plus double occupancy lodging will be FREE for...
 - i. All enrolled Green County 4-H Adult Volunteers
 - ii. First 10 Green County 4-H youth who register (email Ellen to request enrollment approved!!!)
- **20.** Livestock Auction Financial Form Turn in directly to Green County Extension Office by Wednesday, October 1, 2025 at 4:30pm. Auction forms should NOT to be accepted by 4-H Leaders! This form must be completed to be eligible to sell animals in next year's Green County Fair Auction. Use a separate form for EACH livestock project sold in the auction. Livestock species include: Market Steers, Barrows, Lambs, Poultry, Rabbits and Goats.
- 21. Green County Fair July 15-19, 2026
 - a. Clubs can pick up Junior Exhibitor Checks at the Extension Office
 - b. Fair Board considering moving back to Conference Style Judging for non-animal exhibits
