

16. Reminder of **Green County 4-H Member Attendance Policy** in [2025-2026 4-H Enrollment, Project & Policy Guide](#):

- Attend at least four (4) 4-H meetings, events or workshops, between September 1, 2025 and April 21, 2026, with at least two (2) being 4-H club meetings.
 - If you attend a county 4-H meeting, event, or workshop that you would like to count toward this attendance requirement, it is the responsibility of the member and family to notify the 4-H Club Organizational Leader.
 - Members who have graduated from high school and are enrolled in post-high school educational opportunities outside the area are waived from this requirement, but encouraged to attend when possible.
- In early April, one Organizational Leader in each club will be sent a link to a Qualtrics Survey to report their club's 2026 Attendance Requirements. Leaders MUST respond by Wednesday, April 22.)**

- Junior Class
 - Read the General Rules AND each Department document that exhibiting in
 - Fair Entries: April 21 – May 21, 2026
 - Adult Leaders wishing to be eligible for discounted season pass MUST be approved by 4/21/26
 - GCF again requires that all youth exhibitors (or their family) volunteer for the Fair.
- YQCA – Youth for the Quality Care of Animals – MUST register, pre-pay, do pre-test & post-test online
 - In-Person Option – Saturday, March 28th, 8:45-945am at BTC (cost \$3)
 - Web-Based – Anytime (Cost \$12)
- Swine, Lamb & Goat ID Procedure – NEW in 2026, all 3 species will have an ID window of March 23-April 17, 2026. No photo ID's will be accepted after April 17, 2026 at 4:30pm. New this year, identification forms can be turned in via paper form or using the google form. The Extension Office will be CLOSED on Friday, April 3rd. You will be able to drop off forms in the drop box, but you cannot pick up forms or tags on that date. We strongly encourage families to purchase their own taggers for availability and biosecurity reasons.
